The NetPC retailed at \$100, disrupted the PC market. In the last 15 years the company has established itself as a pioneer in providing enterprise-grade management, security and mobility solutions for Managed Computing as a Service (MCaaS) concept, across devices and platforms. Novatium's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) and bundled computing management solution across the cloud, offers contextual management of user's computing services, devices, network and applications. These solutions are available globally in over 600,000 devices and are most relevant today, in a pandemic-hit world.



With remote working being the new normal, Novatium MDM, the largest deployed end point management solution in India, is the most needed business-enabler for employers across the country. It is a cloud-based computing management software that is capable of contextually managing and monitoring devices remotely aiding security, profile management and policy enforcement. It facilitates large sections of employees to work from home as it provides a centralized management control centre enabling administrators to easily deploy applications, content and set rules based to geographically scattered users. Another aspect of the solution is the webbased dashboard, containing audit trails and reports, which enables the organisation to make informed decisions. MDM is deployed across 12 states in India.
