
WOMEN LEADING IITM QUARTERLY REPORT 2021- 2022

WOMEN LEADING IITM (WLI)

Women are the heart and soul of the world. A nation's progress is marked by the progress of its women. This is what IIT Madras has been doing since the beginning to empower women. Ms. Mira Ziaudin joined IITM as the first female faculty in 1962. In 1968, Ms. M. A. Vedavalli became the first female graduate from IITM receiving her B.Tech. in Electrical Engineering degree from Dr. Vikram A. Sarabhai. Since then, it has been a parade of firsts, the first women's hostel – Sarayu came up in 1967, Dr. Usha Titus became the first female Registrar in 2003, Prof. Kamala Krithivasan became the first woman to head a department at IIT Madras in 1992, Prof. Ligy Philip took over as the first female Dean in 2017, and the list goes on.

Recognizing the importance of women in society and the various challenges they have to often overcome, IIT Madras has started Women Leading IITM to recruit-secure-promote-nurture-support women. The priorities of this initiative are to fund late-year Ph.D. students, come up with innovative projects to address obstacles facing career growth, offer mentorship to a substantial number of women in IITM, create administrative support for women's initiatives, and for childcare.

An all-women selection committee consisting of IITM faculty members, ACR member, 1 IITMAA member, 1 IITMF board member, and an honorary member, selected 18 awardees to be supported in 2021-22 from a total of 51 applicants. Even the non-awardees will be mentored to help secure alternate funding.
