
Dear Sant Rajinder Singh Ji Maharaj,

He is a Member (nominated by HRD, Govt. of India) of the Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, Shimla. Amongst the various recognitions, he was conferred the title "Vidyānidhi" by HH Rangapriya Swamiji (Bangalore), and International Merit Award for a paper on Machine Translation. He is a Member of the Academic Council, Veda Vijnana Shodha Samsthanam, Channenahalli. He has authored/edited over 30 volumes and has several publications.

BROAD AREA OF RESEARCH

His area of research is Sanskrit literature in general including grammar and lexicography. He has authored/edited several books on Sanskrit grammar and literature and continues to work in these areas.

CURRENT RESEARCH

He is currently looking into some aspects of the philosophies of Sāṅkhya, Yoga, and the Upaniṣad-s. He is also writing and developing courses to teach specific aspects of the subjects to students at various levels.
