Overview:

The Rooftop Solar Power Plant at IITM Hostels, viz. Tunga, Bhadra and Sabarmati and Central Library was set up through the contributions of batch 1995 and 1975. The plant was inaugurated on 19th of July 2018 at Sabarmati Hostel, IIT Madras.





The total capacity of the installed is 184.14 KW and it generates about 825 KWH energy per day. The annual savings of total installed capacity of the plant is Rs.25.20 Lakhs.









Capacity bifurcation of the plants:

Hostel	Capacity
Rooftop capacity of Tunga	37.62 kW
Rooftop capacity of Bhadra	37.62 kW
Rooftop capacity of Sabarmati	37.62 kW
Rooftop capacity of Central library	71.28 kW
Total Plant capacity	184.14 kW









Solar panels across the campus:

Most of the buildings at IIT Madras campus are powered by Solar Panels, an initiative towards the energy conservation. Located amidst beautiful flora and fauna, IITM focuses on conserving the environment and reducing the carbon footprint.

The Solar Panels have a total capacity of about 3.2 MW and it generates about 3 Lakh K.W.H units of energy in a month.

This is highly economical and has contributed to a high savings in terms of energy as well as monetary.

Indian Institute of Technology Madras inaugurated its largest student's hostel inside the campus to accommodate nearly 1,200 students. All hostels in the IIT Madras campus are named after Indian rivers.

The hostel was built without much delay despite the Covid pandemic in and it caters to all the home and relaxation needs of the students. The building is designed in such a way that sufficient light enters each corridor and each room. The Interaction area with transparent light roofing at the terrace level is provided for casual relaxation of students.
