OBJECTIVE

IIT-Madras to become the first IIT to eliminate “tuition fee” as a barrier to entry through scholarships set up in perpetuity. The total amount of tuition fees is Rs 2 Lakhs out of which 2/3rd is paid by the Government and 1/3rd which accounts to Rs 66,667 is supported through this scholarship. This endowment will allow us to cover 100% of the tuition costs, for deserving students in perpetuity. Limited family income will no longer be a barrier for talented students to attend IIT Madras
